## 2010 Team Travel Policies

- Each 12u-14u team will have a travel manager to book hotels. For 15u-17u, each age group will have one travel manager to book hotels.

- 1 double, non-smoking room will be reserved for each player/family. If you need more rooms, please let the travel manager know.
- Hotel criteria:
  - Double, non-smoking rooms
  - \$80-\$90 rate target, some places we will have to pay \$100+
  - Within 15 minutes of the fields
  - Reliable name brand chain
- Once the hotel block is reserved, parents are responsible for calling the hotel and giving the hotel a credit card number to hold the reservation.
  There will be a cutoff date when this must occur. We will not hold rooms past the cutoff date.
- If you are not attending a specific travel tournament or your son will be staying with another family, please let the travel manager know. We will remove your name from the rooming list for that tournament.
- 15u-18u players will be allowed to room together if their parents are not able to attend the tournament. In these situations, one of the coaches will be responsible for supervising these players. But, you need to let your coach and travel manager know in advance!!!
- 15u-18u teams will be doing team bus trips to select tournaments. The Gamers program will take care of all hotel and transportation arrangements for these trips. Parent attendance at these tournaments will be optional. More details, including costs, will be provided soon.
- Players are not allowed to drive themselves to out-of-town tournaments.
- For 15u-18u players, it is mandatory that all players stay in the team hotel. For 13u and 14u players, this is strongly recommended but not mandatory.
- There are 3 simple rules for Gamers players at hotels:
  - 1. Be respectful of other guests
  - 2. Be respectful of the hotel property
  - 3. Be a positive reflection of the Gamers program, including being dressed properly when wearing the Gamers uniform.
- Individual team coaches will set other rules regarding curfew times, team meals, meeting locations, etc...
